Background

The Michigan High School Baseball Association, along with the Prostate Cancer Foundation (PCF) and the Detroit Tigers, want your high school baseball team to "step up to the plate" to beat Prostate Cancer.

Prostate Cancer **IS** a beatable opponent but it will take an impressive lineup to achieve this victory – research, education, and funding. With education and funding, the research will continue.

EDUCATION: To overall survival rate for prostate cancer is 99.7%. Maintaining this, however, requires early detection amongst all men – including young men.

FUNDRAISING: Many believe we are close to finding a cure to this disease but the fight is not over. Therefore, it is important we do what we can to continue to raise funds so this important research can continue.

How Can Your Team Get Involved?

There are many ways your team can get involved.

- ◆ Pick a scheduled game during the month of May for your "Strike Out Prostate Cancer" game.

 - Press coverage
